CIRCLE TIME SESSIONS

ABSENT FROM PLAYGROUP

SICKNESS



If your child is unwell please do not send them Playgroup! However, please let us know if your child is absent so that we can mark our records accordingly by calling or texting on 07999 824478, by email or through the Facebook page. Please note that children need to be kept at home until **48 hours** after the last episode of diarrhoea or vomiting. This is really important so that we do not make the other children unwell.

If you are lucky enough to be going away on holiday please let your child's key person, Sara or Karen know so that we don't worry about your child's absence. You can either tell us in person or by phone, text or email.

POLITE NOTICE:
